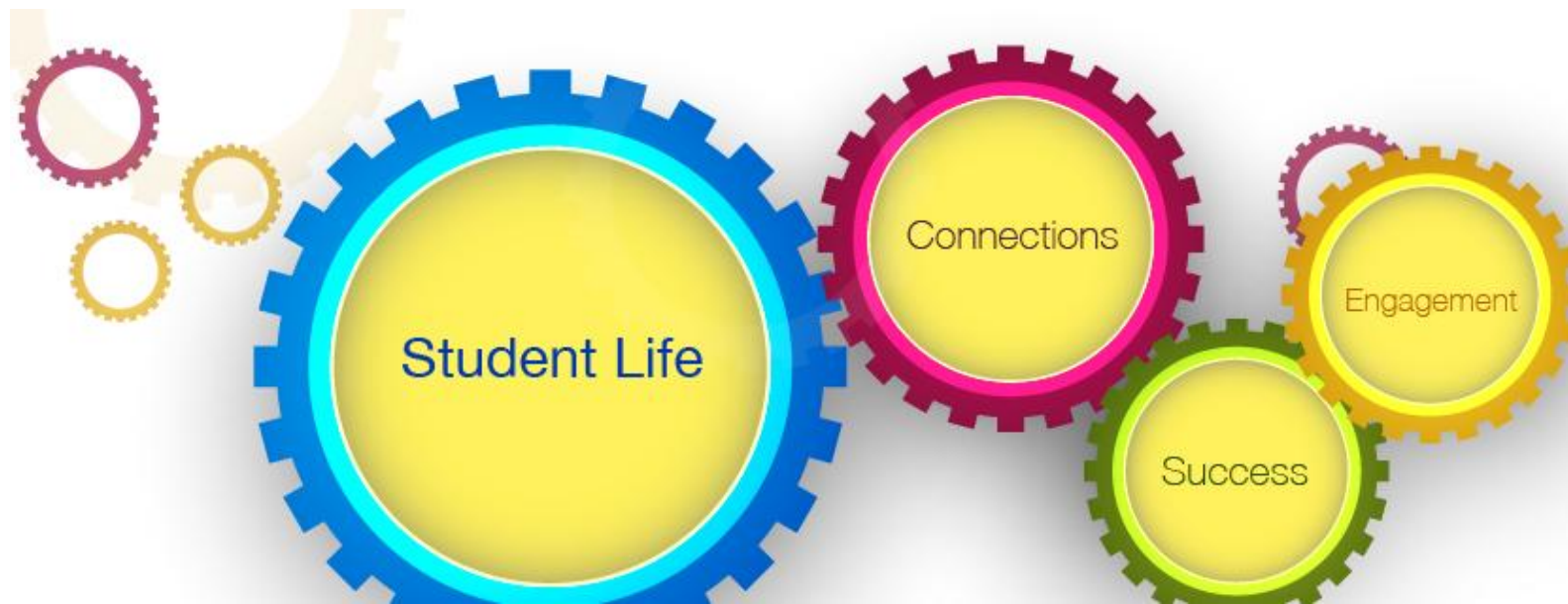

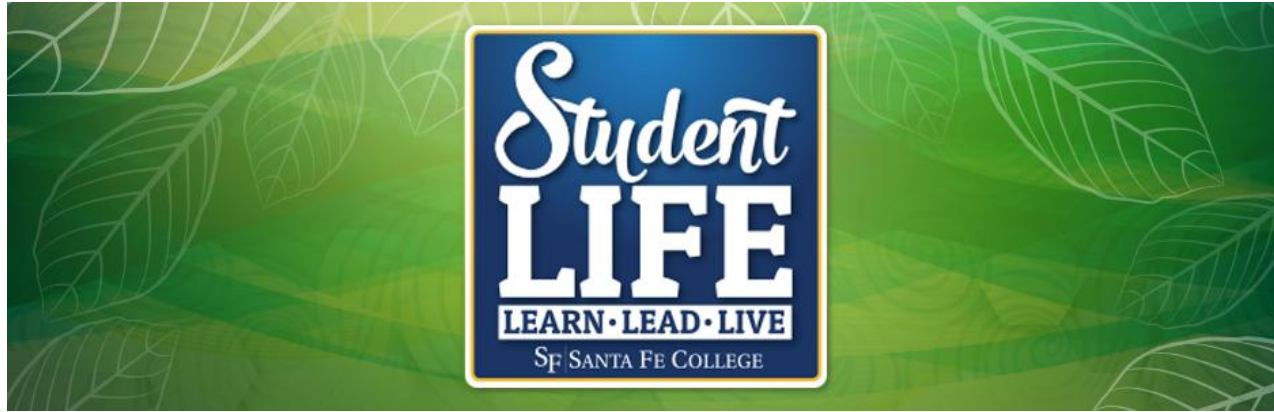


Student Development Theories

- ▶ Student Organizations are supported and funded through SG



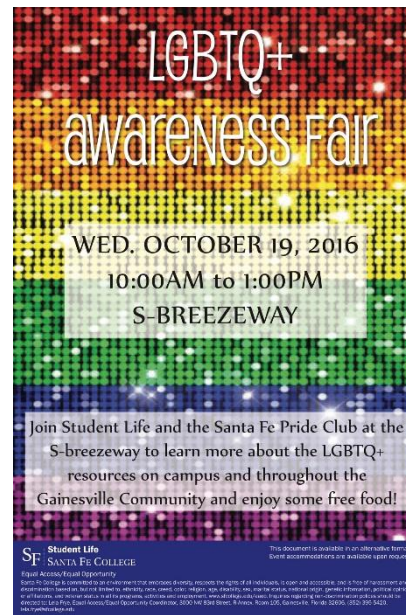
Clubs/Organizations
